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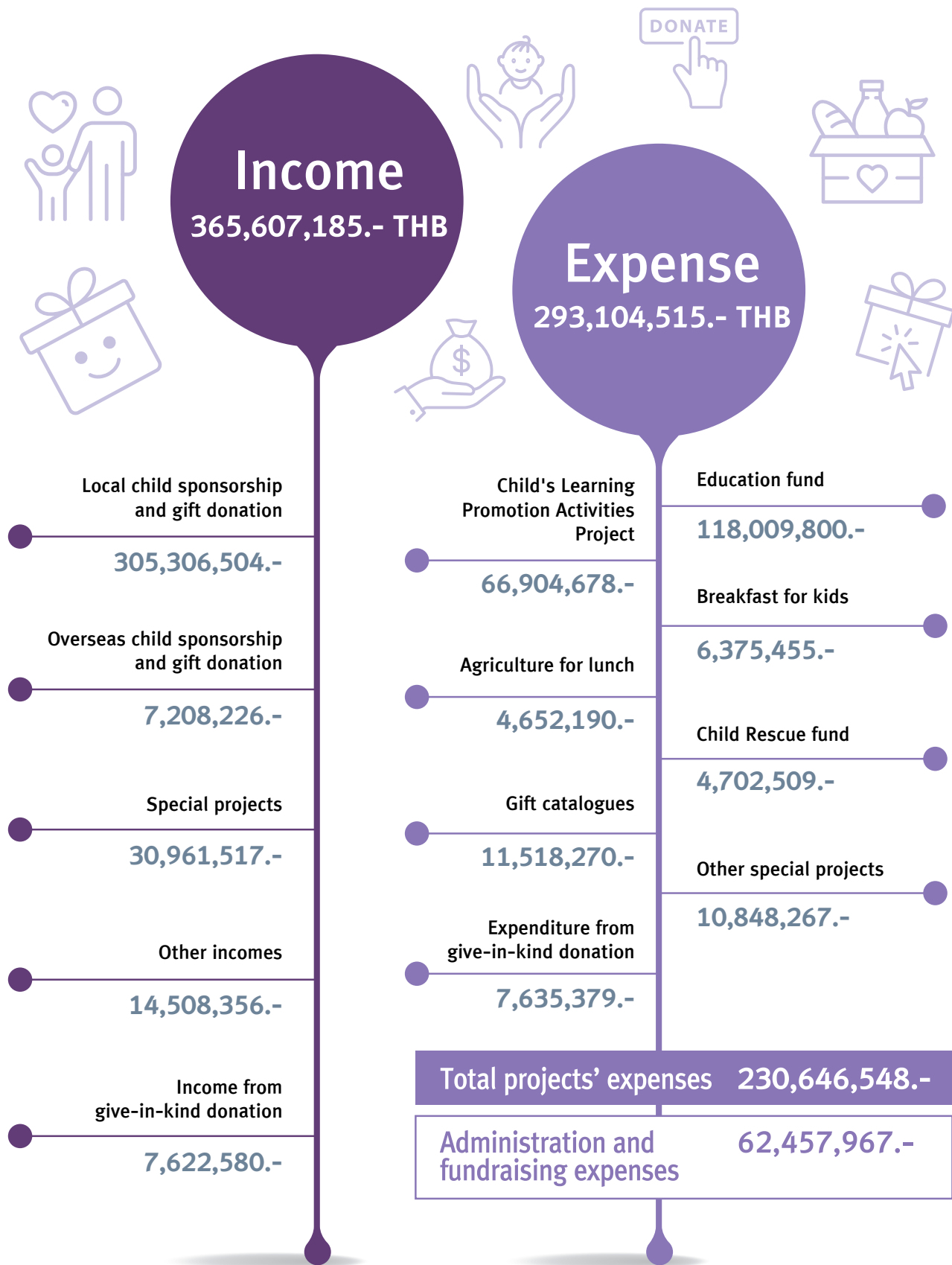
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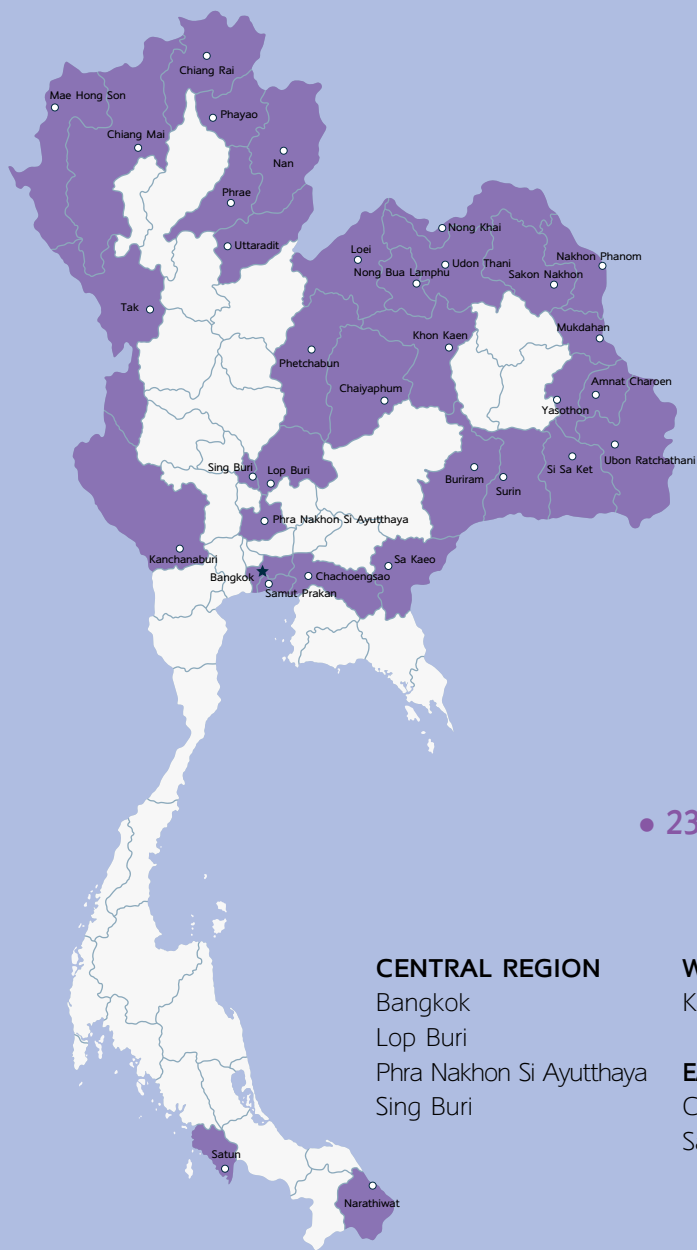

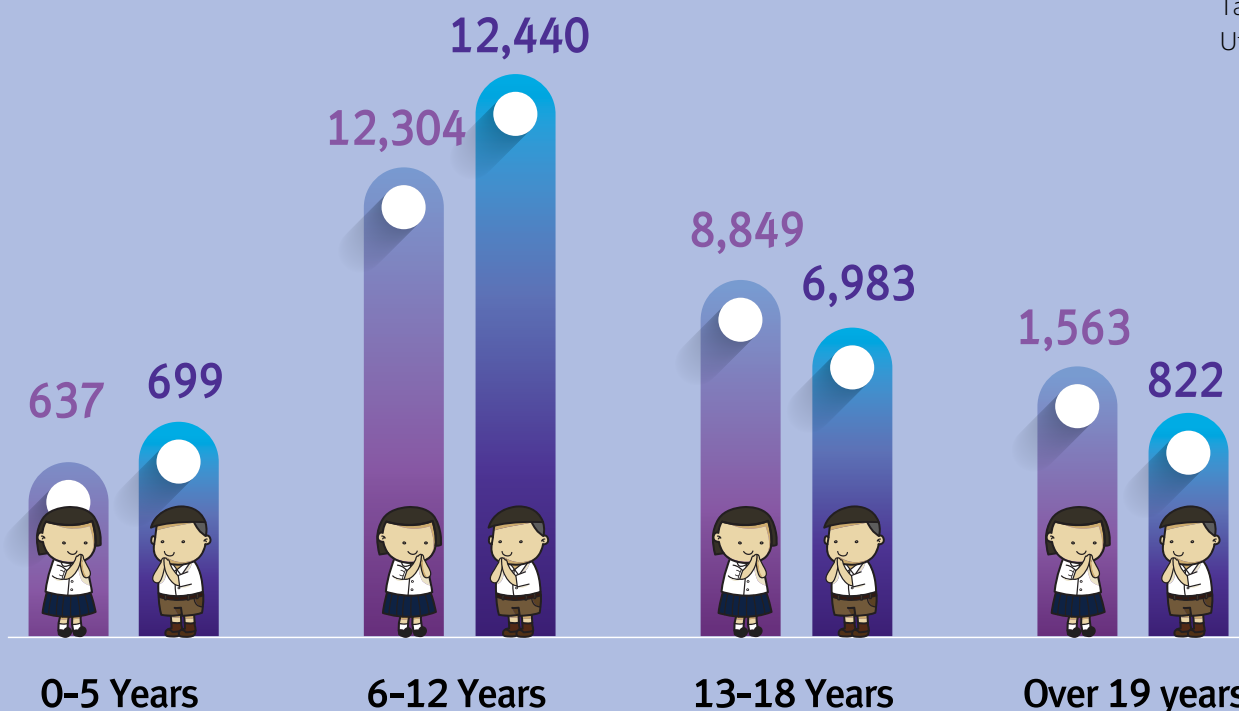

# EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE REPORT FOR COVID-19 Crisis and a new way of life

The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic continues, significantly impacting underprivileged children and families and creating more difficulty in their daily lives. Family members who left home to work in the big cities had to move back while the employment in the area has decreased. Thus, they must adapt to the new normal life, for both safety and occupation.

Two years ago, Community Children Foundation (CCF) assisted in alleviating the emergency distress of children, families, and communities in many dimensions. In the short term, CCF gave them a survival kit to help them protect themselves from the epidemic, including dry food. In the long term, CCF supports building food sources in households and communities to provide them with sufficient food. It also gave children books and learning supplies to promote knowledge from studying at home with a clean cloth set that can be safely used at school. The help and support from sponsors and donors enabled the foundation to relieve the suffering of people and families; details are as follows:-



## Details of items given to children, families, and communities

- Health kits/bags to promote good health with equipment to prevent infection, such as sanitary masks and hand sanitizer alcohol gel.
- Happy read and write bags provided books and plant seeds to create a food source.
- Clean bag/survival kits for kids provided self-protection equipment, face sanitary masks, hand alcohol gel, toothbrush set with a clean cloth bag.

In addition, CCF also provided health training, organizing schools to be agriculture community for safe food storage and training to enhance knowledge of new normal life for safe health.

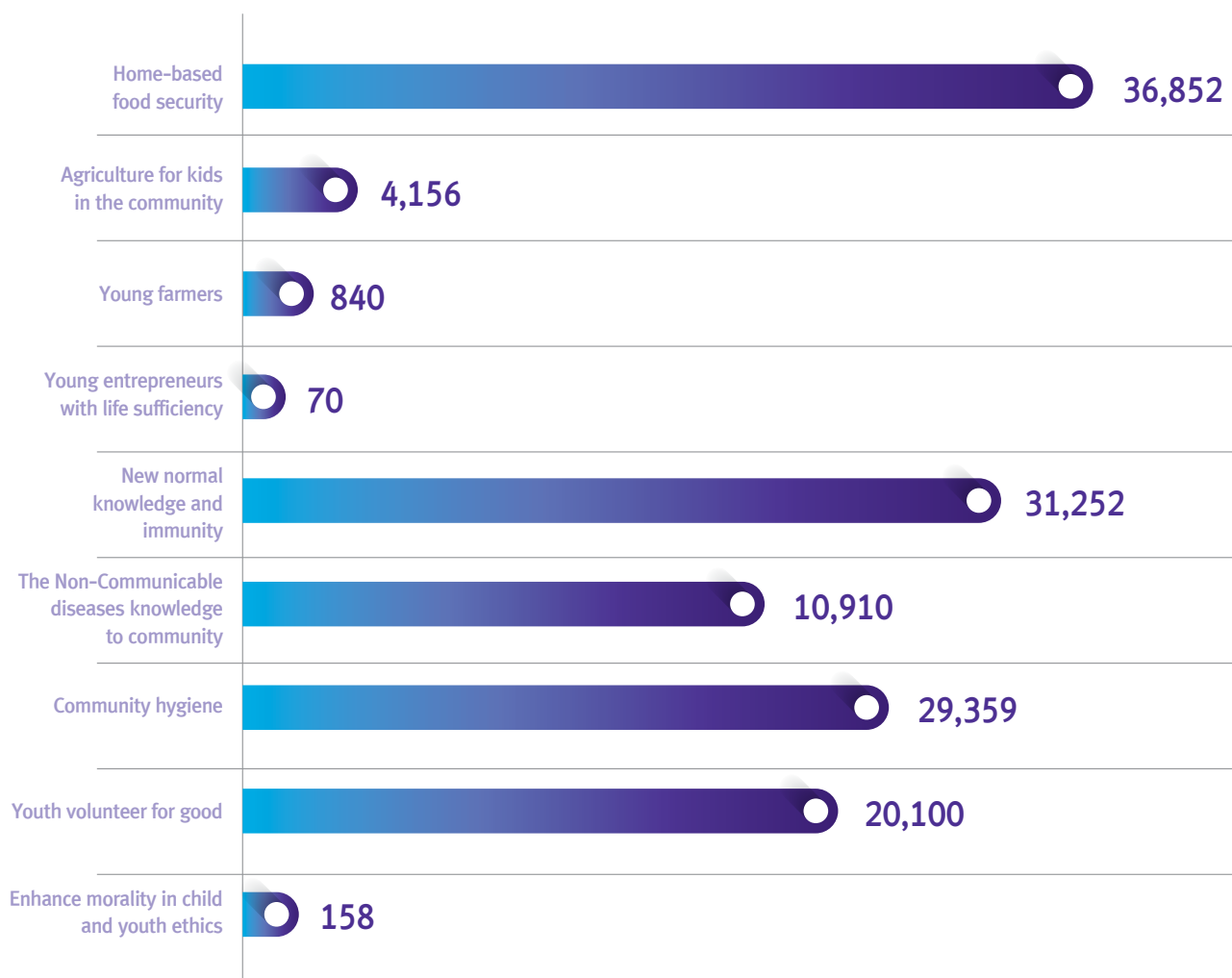

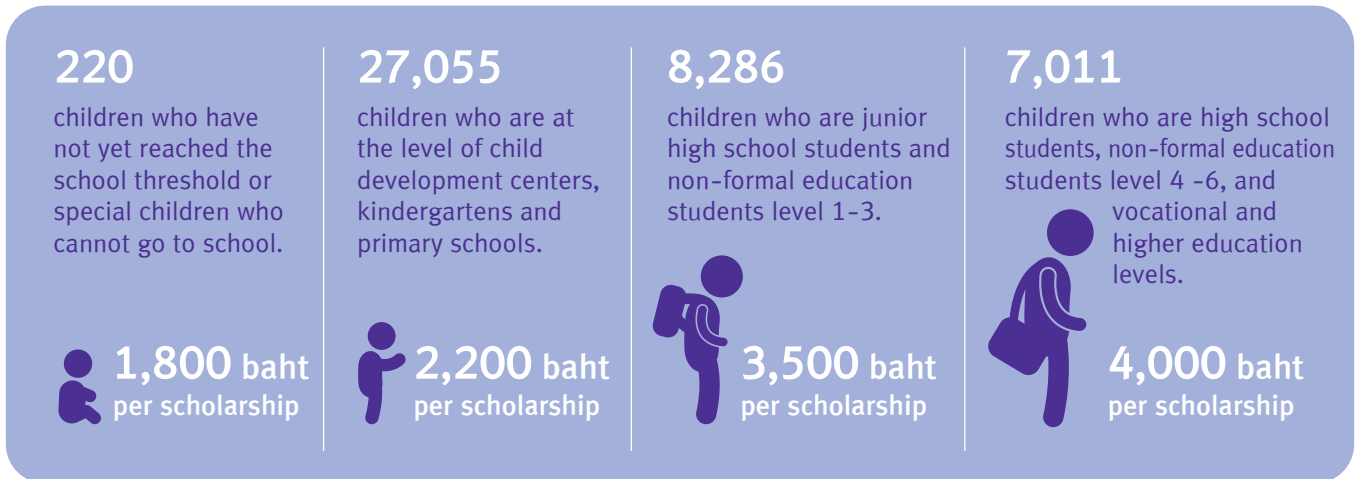

**Community Children Foundation (CCF)** is committed to developing children and youth to be intelligent and good people through several projects. The Education Fund project is one of the main project established to provide scholarships to children of each age group. Because CCF believes that education is an important foundation that will help children develop into quality adults, and most importantly, it helps to alleviate the burden of parents' expenses.

In 2021, CCF gave **42,572 scholarships** to children with a total budget of **116,926,000 baht**. The number of children received is divided into groups:

### Home-based food security Project

Including received mushroom spores, laying hens, broilers, and fish breeds as a source of safe food or for sharing and exchanging among neighbors.

### Agriculture for kids in the community Project

(Scan to view project details)

Aims to help people in the community have secure food sources. The project will utilize the abandoned land in the community or schools and convert it into agricultural plots, livestock cultivation, animal husbandry, fish farming, and water resource development to develop a project model for children and families.

### From a seed to the community sustainability

From 2020 to 2021, CCF Foundation has carried out the project as a model community for growing vegetables in the kitchen garden to build food security, enhance the way of sufficiency, and create a continuous vegetable growing trend in 5 communities in 5 provinces, namely Phetchabun, Tak, Uttaradit, Loei, and Phrae. The project benefits **4,156** people in the community.

## Young Farmers Project

(Scan to view project details)

Aims to practice children the agriculture skill at school. They learn to plan cost accounting, record income expenses, and can add up from their household food sources to eat or sell to generate income for the family. From 2020 to 2021, CCF Foundation operated a project in 3 schools, namely Ban Wang Takee School, Ban Nong Krathum School, and Ban Nong Kung Mai School in Chaiyaphum Province. The project also organized various activities in the school, such as teaching mushroom cultivation, fish farming, vegetable gardening, duck, chicken, pig, and frog farming, and training on Bokashi composting, fertilizer, and insect repellent. A total of **840 students** benefited.

## Young Entrepreneur Plus Project

(Scan to view project details)

Allows children and youth to learn, know themselves, build knowledge, act, and build on becoming young entrepreneurs in the future. The scheme allows high school students to use resources and raw materials available in the community to process, eat, and share with neighbors. Moreover, they sell products to earn income for themselves, their families, and the community, such as oyster mushroom business and processing, local chickens, and earthworm fertilizer business.

From 2020 to 2021 CCF Foundation supported **70 children** to learn and being a young businessman in 2 project areas in Khon Kaen and Chiang Rai Province.

# HEALTH, HYGIENE, SANITATION, SAFETY AND DISEASE-FREE



## New Normal knowledge and immunity Project

(Scan to view project details)

Children, youth, and parents learn and change their behaviors to achieve health care, safe living, and disease-free and are happy in new normal ways. The project provided training, such as setting up a learning base, learning through media, practicing the proper skills, 7 steps of hand washing, learning how to use and dispose of masks correctly, and knowledge of COVID-19.

- **31,252 children and youth** children and youth participated in the training activities in 29 provinces where projects operated.
- **952 children and youth leaders** help mentor activities in the areas.
- **942 Network agency partners**, such as the Provincial Public Health Office, Tambon Health Promoting Hospital, Village Health Volunteer, Municipality/Subdistrict Administrative Organization, and NGO networks working on health, etc., gave support and collaborated..

## The Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) knowledge to community Project

(Scan to view project details)

Promote knowledge for children, families, schools, and communities on health care and avoid chronic non-communicable diseases such as stroke, cardiovascular disease, blood pressure, diabetes, and obesity. The project is in the cooperation with network partners such as the NHSO, teachers, community leaders, and sub-district administrative organizations in 15 projects in 14 provinces, namely Chiang Rai, Mae Hong Son, Uttaradit, Ubon Ratchathani, Mukdahan, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Bueng Kan, Amnat Charoen, Yasothon, Sisaket, Surin, and Buriram. CCF Foundation organized training activities to educate about chronic non-communicable diseases for **10,910 children/parents** participating in the activity.

## Community Hygiene Project

(Scan to view project details)

Encourage children to be aware of cleanliness, understand the dangers of waste, and learn how to separate and recycle trash for the health of everyone in the school and community. The activities were held in 9 areas in 6 provinces, namely Udon Thani, Ubon Ratchathani, Nong Khai, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, and Bueng Kan. With a total of **29,359 children** benefited.



*There was a lot of garbage in the past because students were inexperienced in getting rid of trash and did not know the correct waste separation method. The students, therefore, throw out various rubbish into the same tank. After attending the training, children learn a waste separation which has four types using the 3Rs principle, recycling waste into the production process, and bringing the product to use again. ## BRIGHTEN THE LIFE OF A CHILD

**Community Children Foundation (CCF)** desires to see every child's life improve, regardless of their status. CCF Foundation organizes a "Child Rescue fund" for the lives of underprivileged children who are in a tough situation and suffer to live their everyday lives. In particular, children with multiple repetitive problems such as housing problems, ill physical health, disabled, or lack of caregivers. From 2020 to 2021, CCF Foundation has helped the total number of **118 children** divided into the following groups:

**'Nong Mai'** has had autism and epilepsy since childhood causing problems with the nervous system and trouble walking. Because of her twisted feet, she needs to wear shoes to bend the feet and curvature of the spine and wear a shirt to straighten her back. Nong Mai received help from CCF Foundation to see a doctor at Sunpasitthiprasong Hospital in Ubon Ratchathani Province. She received physical therapy and care from an orthopedic surgeon and neurologist, and if her body is more ready, she will undergo surgery to reposition the bone. Moreover, Nong Mai also received money to help support food, eggs, and milk for better health.

**'Nong Bass'** lives with his father, mother, and brother, both Nong Bass and his brother are mentally disabled and unable to sit, walk, or stand. But Nong Bass has other congenital diseases such as allergies and lung diseases. His parents had to closely taken care of him that they would take him to work as rubber tappers while he slept at the rubber plantation. They often have to take him to the hospital because he exposes to dust from the rubber forest. Therefore, there are additional expenses, such as traveling to the hospital and food, and his mother has to stop working to watch over him, making her miss another income. Nong Bass receives rice, dry food, and supplementary food from giving the family a better life. They also receive support from the Office of Social Development and Human Security with a grant from the Child Protection Fund to buy consumables, household consumption, and travel expenses to the doctor to help lighten the burden on the family.

CCF Foundation delivered gifts from your love to **5,188** children, totaling **4,836,000** baht. # AT SC JOHNSON, WE'RE AT WORK FOR A BETTER WORLD, HELPING MAKE COMMUNITIES STRONGER AND HEALTHIER.



**At SC Johnson**, we have always believed that we should positively impact communities worldwide. We should help make that place better wherever we operate because we are there. During the past COVID-19 epidemic, partnering with Community Children Foundation (CCF) allowed us to reach nearly 19,000 under-served children, teachers & caregivers across 94 schools in nine provinces in Thailand. It has enabled us to help reduce the risk of vector-borne diseases in the communities, through Baygon® products, in addition to keeping school facilities clean with Mr. Muscle® home cleaning products throughout the pandemic.

For education and well-being development, we had the opportunity to provide STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics Education) education for 1,000 students in 20 schools across five provinces, namely Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Nan, Mukdahan, and Amnat Charoen. Moreover, we supported financial aid for 400 children at risk to access primary education, proper hygiene facilities, medical care, and safe living spaces for over 600 children at risk. Five rural schools across several provinces in Thailand, namely Mae Hong Son, Ubon Ratchathani, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, and Sa Kaeo, were upgraded so that 600 under-served children were able to access clean and safe facilities while attending school. Including supporting 30 children in crisis across eight provinces, namely Chiang Mai, Tak, Phetchabun, Nakhon Pathom, Chaiyaphum, Yasothorn, Si Sa Ket, and Sakon Nakhon, to have better lives.

We are proud of our partnership with CCF Foundation, and we look forward to future collaborations so that we may enable more families to have equitable access to education, social mobility, and a better quality of life.”
